In the Driver Education course, students will develop the habits, knowledge, skills, attitude that are necessary to operate a motor vehicle safely and efficiently. The course content will emphasize the personal and social implications that are pertinent to the safe and efficient operation of a motor vehicle. Students will be engaged in a variety of tasks to prepare them to navigate the roadways. Topics will include the responsibilities of driving, rules of the road, traffic procedures, safe driving concepts, the legal obligations of driving, alcohol and drug use as related to driving, and distracted driving.



Students are required to attend 56 hours of classroom instruction; which indicates attendance is a plus and students are only allowed 10 days missed; excused or unexcused. Also, students must pass their final exam with a 70% in order to receive their Certificate of Completion, which allows the student to obtain their Provisional License. Students must also complete 50 hours of drive time; 10 of those being at night, with a licensed adult of at least 21 years of age and licensed for 3 years. This will be done outside class time and the school does not provide the drive time for the student.
